ESSAY EXAMS

- Decide precisely what the question is asking
 - > ex. Describe, Compare, Contrast, Prove, Summarize, etc.
- Make a quick outline
- Get to the point, avoid "fluff"
- Put the most solid supporting points first
- Write legibly usually use a pen
- Use one side of the paper only

OPEN BOOK

- Do not underestimate the difficulty of this test type
- Write formulas you need on a separate sheet
- Place Post-It® notes or paper clips on important pages
- Organize your class notes
- Make a short version of what pages you will find content in your text
- Budget your time! It is easy to spend too much time on one question
