<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BIO 1111</b></p> <p><i>Spring Enrollment Yearlong class</i></p>	<p><b>General College Biology</b></p> <p><b>High School Instructor: Christine Stricker</b></p> <p>Examines the fundamental molecular, cellular and genetic principles characterizing plants and animals. Includes cell structure and function, and the metabolic processes of respiration, and photosynthesis, as well as cell reproduction and basic concepts of heredity. The course includes laboratory experience.
