



## Red Rocks Community College Emergency Medical Responder Course Information



The Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course at Red Rocks Community College designed to teach people to care for ill or injured patients until an ambulance arrives. It is ideal for anyone wishing to obtain comprehensive advanced first aid skills. Participants may include police officers, park rangers, camp counselors, and volunteer firefighters. It is also an excellent preparation course for students considering becoming an EMT. Upon successful completion of the course students are eligible to take the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT) Emergency Medical Responder written and practical certification exam. Upon successful completion of the NREMT exam you will be able to apply for Colorado EMR certification.

The format is approximately half lecture and half small group skills practice. The only pre-requisite is age 16 by the first day of class. Biology 106 is a recommended co-requisite if you plan to continue your EMS education beyond the EMR level.

NREMT certification requires CPR certification. Enrolling in HPR 1101 will provide the student the American Heart Association CPR for BLS providers training and certification.

### Registration:

Registration begins near the end of the preceding semester, generally early April and November. Students are admitted to the program on a first-come, first-served basis. EMS 1015 is open enrollment and may be completed online. ### Program Cost:

Colorado resident tuition and fees for the EMR course are based upon 3 credits plus fees, approximately \$700. Costs for required textbooks and equipment are approximately \$200. Testing and certification costs for the National Registry of EMTs, after course completion, are approximately \$145. **All tuition and costs listed are approximate and subject to change.**
